**TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE COUNTY OF MUSKEGON, STATE OF MICHIGAN:** Notice is hereby given, that a **SPECIAL ELECTION** will be held in all precincts in Muskegon County, Michigan on **TUESDAY, MAY 6, 2025** from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

The following proposals will appear on the ballot at the Tuesday, May 6, 2025 election:

**COUNTY OF MUSKEGON  
MUSEUM MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Shall the County of Muskegon, Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed .31 mill (\$.31 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a new additional millage, against all taxable property within Muskegon County for a period of twenty (20) years, 2025 to 2044, inclusive, for the purpose of constructing new museum space, renovating the existing museum, updating exhibits and purchasing furniture, fixtures and equipment for the Muskegon Museum of History & Science, which is part of the Lakeshore Museum Center, and any other museum purpose authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue Muskegon County will collect if the millage is approved and levied in the first year (2025) is approximately \$1,900,000. By law, a portion of the millage may be subject to capture by brownfield redevelopment authorities and those authorities governed by the Decodified Tax Increment Financing Act, 2018 PA 57, including downtown development authorities and local finance development authorities in the County of Muskegon.
