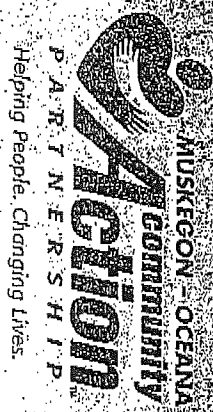

MOCAP

Muskegon-Oceana Community Action Partnership, Inc. (MOCAP) is a private non-profit 501(c)(3) community action agency, committed to fighting the causes, conditions and effects of poverty, by helping low-income people become more self-sufficient, improving the conditions in which they live, and enabling them to own stake in their communities.

MOCAP provides multiple programs designed to diminish the causes and effects of poverty through emergency food assistance, utility assistance, financial counseling as well as housing education.

MOCAP SERVICES

Emergency Services

MOCAP operates a variety of programs that can assist families and individuals with emergency needs. Services include assistance with housing costs to prevent eviction or eliminate homelessness, assistance with utility bills to prevent shut-offs, to restore services or to acquire deliverable fuels.

Food and Nutrition Programs

MOCAP operates (The Emergency Food Assistance Program) TEFAP program, which on a quarterly basis, provides healthy, nutritious foods intended to supplement the nutritional needs of eligible families and individuals. Each of MOCAP's Community Action Centers has a food pantry that provides emergency food free of charge to clients.

MUSKEGON-OCEANA AFFORDABLE HOUSING INITIATIVE

Homebuyer Education

Two part class that focuses on helping people become knowledgeable home-buyers. Learn how to determine if you are ready for homeownership; how to manage your budget; find the right home; realtor; lender; what happens at closing; and who's going to do the repairs. Classes are free and open to everyone. Registration is required.

Credit counseling

After attending Homebuyer Education, you can schedule an appointment with a housing counselor to get assistance working on your spending plan. We can also pull a credit report, review it with you, and create an action plan to work on credit issues.

Foreclosure Intervention and Counseling

Counseling provided to homeowners who are behind or are going to fall behind on their mortgage. The home must be the borrower's primary residence and owner occupied. No fee for assistance.
